





No Parking:

No public parking at King Memorial Station or The Carter Center. Use MARTA rail station parking or ride-sharing services.

Important Reminders

Fare Required:

The shuttle is free, but fare is required to ride MARTA. For easy tap and go payment, download the Breeze Mobile 2.0 app for Apole or Android.

No Bags:

Bags, purses, and backpacks are **prohibited** on the shuttles and at The Carter Center. Prohibited items will be surrendered and not returned.


Wayfinding Signage: to direct mourners to take the free shuttle to The Carter Center and provide key event information

Digital Screens at MARTA headquarters and in all garages featured President Carter's memorial image




